Registration Time Limits



The Degree is split into three levels; the Certificate (level 4), Diploma (level 5) and then the Degree (level 6). Once you register with the University of Wales you should work towards completing 40 credits per year. If you can keep to this schedule then you will be on target to complete **each level in three years**.

You have three choices; you could (1) complete just the Certificate (2) complete the Diploma (meaning completing the Certificate first) or (3) complete the full Degree.

Should you start by wanting to study the Certificate and then decide to continue onto the Diploma or Degree, your deadline will still be worked out from the date of registration. Working to the 40 credits per year would enable you to complete the Diploma or Degree within the allotted registration period. However should you require more time per level then you would need to apply formally to Spurgeon's College for an extension. Please note that if a candidate takes longer than the allotted 3 years per level then they will be required to pay an annual college registration fee.
